## **RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council and the Memphis Housing Authority, after a public hearing thereon, are responsible for the authorization and approval of any waiver, cancellation, or discharge of, or amendment to, those certain restrictive covenants affecting the use of certain properties within the Beale Street Urban Renewal Area, Project No. Tennessee, R-77 (the "Renewal Area"); and

**WHEREAS**, certain restrictive covenants are set forth and contained in a Warranty Deed to the Church of God in Christ, Inc. from the City of Memphis, and filed of record at Instrument No. S1 1942 in the Register's Office of Shelby County, Tennessee (the "Restrictive Covenants"), and COGIC is desirous of conveying the land to RPD Hotel Group, LLC for the construction of a hotel facility on their property formally located at Fourth and Linden streets in Memphis, TN; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the restrictive covenants mentioned herein, hotel construction is not a permitted use of the property, unless waiver is sought by a party and received by the legislative bodies of the Memphis Housing Authority, the Memphis City Council, an ownership interest of more than 50% of the property located in the affected area; and

**WHEREAS**, owners of land who collectively own a majority of the land in the Renewal Area have cancelled, waived and discharged the Restrictive Covenants, as evidenced by affidavits attached to this resolution as Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS**, Memphis Housing Authority has approved such waiver, cancellation and discharge of the Restrictive Covenants through resolution approved by its Board of Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, the Memphis City Council desires to approve such waiver, cancellation and discharge of the Restrictive Covenants;

**WHEREAS**, the conveyance under that certain Warranty Deed executed by and between Church of God in Christ, Inc., and Pentecostal Temple Church of God in Christ, and filed of record at Instrument No. S1 6244, aforesaid Register's Office ("S1 6244"), was made subject to the terms and conditions of that certain Option Agreement for Private Redevelopment by and between the and Royal Phoenix Development, LLC and Pentecostal Temple church of God in Christ, Inc., (the "S1 6244 Agreement"), regarding real property more particularly described in S1 6244;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to authorize the waiver, release, and discharge from the property described in S1 6244 the S1 6244 Contract, together with all terms and provisions thereof pursuant to execution by the Mayor of that certain instrument attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Memphis City Council hereby approves the waiver, cancellation and discharge of the Restrictive Covenants by the owners of land who collectively own a majority of the land located within the Renewal Area, as evidenced by affidavits attached hereto as Exhibit "A";

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the City Council hereby authorizes the waiver, release and discharge of the S1 6244 Contract, together with all terms and provisions thereof, pursuant to execution by the Mayor of that certain instrument attached hereto as Exhibit "B";

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution and, once executed, the instrument attached hereto as Exhibit "B", shall be filed of record in the Register's Office of Shelby County, Tennessee.
